



Alerting all CSWIP Welding Inspectors! *Major new employment opportunity*

- National Grid Transco has a proposed pipeline construction programme throughout the UK of over 700Km during 2005/9.
- Experienced BGAS approved Inspection Personnel are a key component in the delivery of these projects.
- Now is the time to consider obtaining a BGAS Welding Inspector Approval and become part of the team delivering the construction process.

Holders of the CSWIP 3.1 and 3.2 Welding Inspector qualifications may take a bridging examination to achieve the BGAS Welding Inspector certificate.

To be eligible to take this route, holders of the CSWIP Welding Inspector must:

- 1 Presently hold the CSWIP qualification above.
- 2 Take a three part bridging examination comprising:
 - i) 30 general multiple choice questions on pipeline welding inspection technology.
 - ii) Practical inspection of plate, fit ups/root runs/finished welds and fittings.
 - iii) Written/Oral on the requirements of Transco Specification P9 – Welding onto Live Mains.

Suitable course(s) are available to support the bridging process.

Success in the above, leads to the award of the BGAS Welding Inspector certificate with full normal validity and normal renewal requirements.

Failure in any one or all parts leads to **one** retest of the failed part(s) to be taken within 26 weeks following the initial test. Any further failure disqualifies the candidate from further bridging examinations. However, the initial route remains available.
